A bid acknowledged by the auctioneer is a legal contract to purchase the item. In the silent auction, designation of the bid you have written by the auction official is a legal contract to purchase that item.

Top bidders may pay for their items at the cashier stations, which will be open for service at the conclusion of the auction. Payment in full is mandatory at the auction.

All purchases are final. No exchanges or refunds unless otherwise noted.

The auctioneer reserves the right to reject any bid which is a minimal fractional advance over the prior bid. We gladly accept your payment by cash, check or credit card. Please make your check payable St. Rose School Auction.

The IRS granted St. Rose School charitable organization status. We are a 501(c) 3 charitable organization and your payments are tax deductible as a contribution, only to the extent provided by law. Generally you may deduct the amount you pay above the fair market of that item unless otherwise noted; all goods and services must be claimed and used within one year of the auction date.

The auctioneer reserves the right to withdraw, without notice, items to and from the auction.

The purchaser is responsible to remove purchases from the auction premises. Certificates can be claimed from the Certificate Table at the Cashier Station with your "paid" receipt. Certificates are for services and tangible items not displayed. Reservations for trips and vacation accommodations must be mutually arranged with the donor unless otherwise noted. No refunds will be allowed on travel packages for cancelled tickets and/or accommodations.

All items are to be removed from the auction premises at the conclusion of the auction. Larger items can be kept overnight and picked up between 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. the following morning at the Cowlitz County Regional Conference Center.

The St. Rose auction committee has attempted to describe and catalog all items correctly, but all items are offered "as is". No statement made in this catalog or made orally at the auction shall be deemed such as warranty for tax purposes or fair market value.

Each bidder assumes all risks and hazards related to the auction and items obtained at the auction. Each bidder agrees to hold harmless from any liability arising there from St. Rose, its elected and appointed officials, members and employees, the auctioneer, the auction company and its agents and employees, the event organizers, sponsors, and/or volunteers connected with the auction.

Fair market value will be reflected on your auction statement.

All silent and live auction items are effective one year from date of purchase, unless otherwise stated.

SILENT AUCTION

Items offered in the silent auction will have silent auction bid forms nearby. You may bid by writing your bid number on the form, opposite the amount you choose to bid. Press hard; you are making four copies.

You may skip ahead on the form to find the amount you want to bid. The next bidder must bid a higher amount to be the successful bidder.

If you choose, write your bid number opposite the amount labeled "Guaranteed Purchase," and you own that item. Once you write your bid number on the guaranteed line, the bidding for that item is concluded.

You may continue to bid on any item in the silent auction until that section is closed. Closing times will be posted. A silent auction official will circle the top bid number and amount. A copy of the bid form will be left on the table near where the item was located where you can see if you were the successful bidder.

LIVE AUCTION

You may preview the live auction items from the time the doors open until the beginning of the live auction. Note any restrictions, limitations, sizes, etc. You may bid in the live auction by holding your bid card high with the number toward the auctioneer. The auctioneer or bid spotter can accept your bid.

EXPRESS PAY SERVICE

At registration, bidders may elect Express Pay, by having their credit card run and signing an attached credit card receipt. Express Pay guests then avoid standing in line to pay for their purchases at the end of the evening and will have paid receipts delivered to them directly during the course of the night.
