

SHARE HOUR IDEAS!

Wondering how to get those share hours done? Following are some ideas to help you. If you are interested in learning more about any of these opportunities, please call the St. Rose School office.

- **Year Round Events** – Scrip, Recess, Art Appreciation, R.I.F., Adopt A “Buddy Family”, Library Help, School Pride, Reader Board Update, Enrollment Committee.
- **Seasonal Events** – Picture Day, Fall Fundraiser, Monster Mash, Santa’s Secret Workshop, End-of-the-Year Field Day, St. Rose School Appeal and Health Screening Day.
- **Special Talent Events** – Special Teacher Projects, Enrichment/Culture Programs, Special Craft Talents, Baked Goods Supplier.

Scrip – This is a great fund raising program, and no extra cost to you. Volunteer duties can include selling scrip at school or mass, record keeping, etc. Even if you don’t volunteer for this program, please purchase Scrip.

Art Appreciation - On the third Tuesday of every month, St. Rose School holds an "Art Appreciation" day for the students. Volunteers present a different type of art (pottery, painting, etc.) or assist the presenter and students with materials.

Picture Day - The day of school pictures, we need volunteers to escort the students back and forth from class to say "cheese!"

Special Projects - Every once in a while, staff and teachers have projects that require additional help. Some “behind the scenes” assistance for an event or project can be done at home. Let us know if we can call on you.

Fall Fellowship Event "Monster Mash" - We need help with candy supplies, setup, clean up, carnival attendants, and more.

Enrichment/Cultural Programs – Special visitors like the Reptile Man and Puppeteers; or other events like Science programs, Musical events, Math programs, etc. always need additional help.

Santa’s Secret Workshop – This allows our children to shop for Mom, Dad, family and friends right here at the school. With your help they can pick out that special present, wrap the gift and take it home.

End-of-the-Year Field Day – We are always in need of parent volunteers to help out with Field Day at the end of the year. Volunteers will help facilitate games, food, and any other duties with staff assistance.

Lunch Relief for Middle School Teachers – Monday through Friday, between 12:30-1:00pm a volunteer is needed to supervise a class while students eat and the teacher goes to lunch.

Recess Helpers – We can always use help with recess. Keeping our children safe and happy while they play is a great way to help out. Times needed are Monday, Wednesday, and Friday 11:30-1:00pm and Tuesday and Thursday 12:00-1:00pm.

Office Help – Have skills in Microsoft Word, Excel, or the phone? There are many levels in each that we need can use your help.

R.I.F. (Reading is Fundamental) – Share the joy of reading when our preschool through 3rd grade students and help them choose a great R.I.F. book. R.I.F. events come about three times per year and are generally in the morning. You can also organize the books between classes.

Fall Fundraiser – We need volunteers to help out with our Fall Fundraiser which begins in early September. Volunteers will help with record keeping, distribution of fundraiser items and student prizes, etc.

Adopt a “Buddy Family” – We always have new families at St. Rose School. Would you like to adopt one? You could be that REAL person to talk to about share hours, Scrip, level 1 dress, the auction, and many more items.

St. Rose School Appeal – This is a fundraising drive. Duties might include mailing letters to families, speaking at mass, etc. In the past, money raised has gone to endowment, tuition assistance and teacher enrichment.

Health Screening Day - During our annual Health Screening Day we need volunteers to escort students back and forth from class to the Health Screening location. In addition, help is needed to shift students from one health station to another.

Library Help - Duties could include shelving books, checking books in and out, straightening shelves, etc.

Special Talent – Throughout the year, we may need to contact someone for advice or help with a project. If you like to sew, garden, craft, or build items, we’d love to have you on the team. Don’t be shy...let us know!

School Pride - Would you like to make our school a little better? Join the School Pride Committee for special duties. Examples include painting a classroom, power washing the outside of the school, etc.

Reader Board updates - We need a volunteer to update the St. Rose reader board 1-2 times per week. This opportunity can be shared among different people and the timing is extremely flexible!

Baked Goods Supplier – Sometimes school events require COOKIES!!! If you enjoy baking or want to get them from the store, all we need is a phone number so we can call you when we need COOKIES!!!

Enrollment Committee - This year-round committee will meet once a month and focus on recruiting new families, in addition to retention of students.
